n your next day out in the city, use this list of 25 kid-friendly things to do in Chicagoland to check off iconic bucket list items or discover a new-to-you hidden gem.

Step out on The Ledge, a glass balcony on the 103rd floor of the iconic Willis Tower, to experience breathtaking views.

2 Get your adrenaline pumping at 360 Chicago. The John Hancock Center's observation deck offers the TILT, leaning guests 1,000 feet over the Magnificent Mile.

Relive Ferris Bueller's Day Off at the Art Institute of Chicago, where kids can admire stained glass and iconic masterpieces.



4 The Griffin Museum of Science and Industry offers hands-on learning with 13 labs, a baby chicken hatchery and more engaging exhibits.



5 Explore **The Field Museum**, where your family can journey through ancient civilizations, marvel at dinosaurs, and meet Chicago's beloved Sue the T. rex!

6 Get your game on! Chicago is a sports lover's dream, offering major league action from the Cubs, Sox, Bulls, Blackhawks, Bears, and more.



7 Maggie Daley Park is a downtown haven for family fun with play structures, spray area, climbing wall, skating ribbon and Chicago-themed mini golf.

Enjoy skyline views, public art, fun activities and yummy eateries along the **Chicago Riverwalk.**

Explore the Lakefront Trail and discover the parks, beach and neighborhoods that surround it.

10 Go for a walk or ride bikes along **The 606** elevated trail.

See a Navy Pier fireworks show. Enjoy free fireworks over Lake Michigan on summer nights, with perfect views all along the lakefront.

12 The Chicago Air and Water

Show, the nation's largest free event of its kind, dazzles late-summer crowds along the lakefront with thrilling airplane stunts over Lake Michigan.

13 Garfield Park Conservatory is a free conservatory with lush, tropical greenhouses, outdoor gardens and children's play gardens. **14** Take the kids to McCormick Place for the **Chicago Auto Show**, the longest running auto exhibition in the country that happens annually in February.

15 Attend the C2E2 comic convention where fans can dress up, meet favorite actors and creators, and explore endless vendor treasures.

16 Immerse yourself in vibrant, interactive installations at **Color Factory** in Willis Tower, then top off your visit with stunning views from the Skydeck for a day full of colorful fun.



17 Go green and celebrate St. Patrick's Day in Chicago with vibrant parades and the iconic river dyeing, turning the Chicago River bright green for a month of festive fun.

18 The Museum of Ice Cream is a sweet escape for families, offering unique ice cream flavors, fun games, a sprinkle pool, and endless selfie opportunities in a pink wonderland.



19 Chicago's **summer street festi-vals** are a family-friendly celebration of art, culture and delicious eats.
